The 27th ICCP World Play Conference will be held on the **15-17th of June 2017**.

The conference is organized by International Council for Children's Play in cooperation with the Play Research Laboratory of Lithuanian University of Educational Sciences, Faculty of Education.



Play is studied across the whole range of academic disciplines, from computing science to sports science and from history to philosophy. Across these diverse disciplines a vast range of methodologies and methods are used to arrive at a better understanding of the fascinating phenomenon of children's play.

'Researching Play - Challenges and Opportunities' aims to share effective ways of researching play and to promote discussion about the methodical challenges faced by play researchers. This conference seeks to stimulate a multidisciplinary exchange of knowledge and experience, and abstracts are welcome from researchers studying play from any discipline.

Abstracts of the presentations for the conference will be accepted till the 15th of December 2016.

The full conference fee is 300 euros, early bird fee is 250 euros, and early bird registration will be available till the **15th of April 2017**.
